



## **2010 WIN Collision Repair Employee Conference Scholarship Award Criteria**

For the year 2010 WIN will offer collision repair employee conference scholarships. These scholarships are open to any female employee of a collision repair business including technicians, office employees and administrators. Each scholarship will provide the recipient with a one-year WIN membership, paid conference fee for that year, and \$125 towards WIN Conference travel. Scholarships will be awarded to as many entrants as financially possible based on their application competitiveness. This year's Conference will be held in Orlando, Florida at the Peabody Hotel, May 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup>.

### **Criteria:**

The following information must be submitted as one packet and received for scholarship consideration by **March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010**:

- A short resume of their work experience(s) as an collision repair employee (technician, office or administration), including information of any related collision repair attained certifications and the complete name/address of their current employer
- A short essay responding to the following question; "*Why I should be considered to receive WIN scholarship monies?*"
- A short recommendation letter from their current collision repair shop manager/owner acknowledging the applicant as an employee in good standing and they will allow the employee to attend the conference if selected.
- A page listing current contact information including name, address, phone numbers and email.
- Scholarship submissions should be mailed to WIN Scholarship Committee; c/o ASE; 101 Blue Seal Drive, Suite 101; Leesburg, VA 20175.

Information about the scholarship opportunity will be sent to the trade press and various associations and information will be posted on the WIN website and will appear in WIN Conference materials.

### **Selection:**

The applicant's criteria packet and related information will be sent to the WIN Scholarship Committee for review and recommendations to the WIN Board. The final approval will be given by the Board. The Scholarship Committee will contact and handle arrangements for the recipients with the Conference Committee and assign a mentor to serve as a hostess at the conference.
