



## **WIN NACE Award Guidelines**

### **GOAL:**

To recognize a woman for her success at the annual SkillsUSA competition and encourage her continued involvement in the collision repair industry

### **AWARD:**

- Award is given in year earned
- Full registration at NACE Conference & Expo
- Transportation and hotel expense for the NACE Conference & Expo
- One-year membership in WIN
- Approximate value: \$1,500

### **CRITERIA:**

- Winner is highest ranking female at SkillsUSA Championships in either the collision repair technology or automotive refinishing technology competitions
  - In the event there are two women who receive the same ranking in each contest, the award will go to the woman with the highest overall score
  - Because the collision repair technology committee currently offers the NACE trip to the first-place high school and college/postsecondary medalists (with no restriction regarding gender), if a woman places first in the Collision Repair Technology contest, then the award will go to the next highest ranked woman in either contest
  - If there is no woman who places in the competition, WIN reserves the right to seek other educational sources to apply this award
- All scoring is the responsibility of SkillsUSA and contestants must adhere to their guidelines and stipulations
- In the event of a tie, SkillsUSA will notify WIN who will make a decision to determine the final award winner

### **OTHER:**

- One award will be given annually
- Award recipient will be given opportunity to network with other women in the industry at the NACE Conference through pre-planned meetings and social gatherings
- WIN reserves the right to administer this award according to stated guidelines while also considering logistics and budget issues that may occur.
